Dear Tracy:

The following is our test report on the pumping characteristics of the C.T.S. product, as tested here on Enuary 17, 1992. We appreciate your confidence in our equipment and the opportunity to be of ervice.

The Rap 1-Set mixed quickly and thoroughly to a smooth, creamy consistency, and was pumped without ifficulty.

Conditions:

Inside Warehouse, Temp. 68° Deg. F.

Equipm nt:

CG-550P Mini-Grout Pump and Mixer, and a 1" I.D. X 50' Grout Hose.

Mixing Yater:

Fresh Water, 68 Deg. F.

Rapid - Set:

3 bags were added to 12 quarts total water in the mixer, mixer blades running at about 60-75 RPM. Creamy smooth, lump-free consistency was observed about 30 seconds after the third bag was added. Batch was pumped and recirculated for 3 minutes. The mix was then pumped back into the mixer. About 11 lbs. of dry material was added to the mixer pumping was resumed without problems.

No disconoration or separation was observed. Materials appeared to stay in suspension without significant settlement of aggregate.

ChemGrout considers this product to be "Excellent" for mixing and pumping through the CG-550.
